MULTIPLE ENTRIES ARE ALLOWED IN THIS TOURNAMENT

1. Entrants must be 50 years or older. Must be a resident of the State of Louisiana for the previous 30 days, and must be a current member or purchase an affiliate membership card prior to bowling the first shift.
2. Entrants will use highest 2016-2017 Yearbook average of 21 or more games unless 2017-2018 league average of 21 or more games is 10 pins or more higher as of October 1, 2017. If a bowler doesn't have a 2016-2017 book average, the highest league average of 21 or more games as of the time of bowling will be used with verification of league secretary. If none of the above, the entrant will bowl scratch (210).
3. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify their average accuracy in a classified or handicap tournament. Failure to use the proper average may disqualify the scores if a submitted average is lower than the actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average. Correction of average can be made up to the completion of the first game of the first series. The tournament director may give a 48 hour extension to the rule if the bowler requests it in writing to the tournament director before the completion of the first game of the first series.
4. Bowlers will bowl six (6) games, consisting of two (2) three (3) game (sets) series for each entry. (or choice of split per shift)
5. Prize fees will be returned 100% to the participants. Prize ratio will be one place for each eight entrants
6. Bowlers may enter this tournament as many times as desired, but may only place one (1) time in prize position standings.
7. DIVISION TIES: All ties for the top position will be broken by determining the high scratch score bowled by the members involved. This will determine the State Representative to the National Tournament.
8. USBC Rule 319c, 319d, and 319e will be in effect. Re-rating by 319c is the bowler's responsibility.
9. Tournament management reserves the right to RE-RATE or REJECT any entry prior to bowling.
10. HANDICAP: will be 90% of the different between 210 and the bowler average.
11. Touring 1 and 2 professionals are not permitted to bowl in this tournament.
12. The use of summer league averages, unless listed as the bowlers' book average, will not be permitted
13. All other USBC Rules not covered above will be in effect for this tournament.
14. Two special divisions are included. Division Class "E" for those 50 through 54 years old will qualify for the National Senior Tournament.
